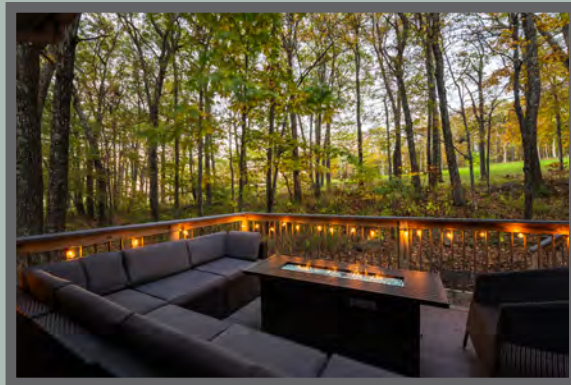

# HOUSE MANUAL



# HOUSE RULES

**No Parties or Events:** To maintain a peaceful environment and respect our neighbors, we do not permit parties, events, or large gatherings.

**No Smoking:** Smoking is strictly prohibited inside and outside the cabin. No illegal substances allowed on the premises.

**Booking Guest Age Minimum:** 25 or older, Host reserves the ability to check ID.

**Occupancy:** The maximum number of guests allowed is as per the booking details. No additional overnight guests are permitted without prior approval from the owner.

**Local Laws & Ordinances:** Guests must comply with all local laws, rules, and ordinances during their stay. Any violation may result in immediate termination of the reservation.

**Check-in / Check-out:** Check-in is 4pm, check-out is 10am. Please respect these times unless otherwise agreed upon in advance. Late check-outs without prior approval will result in additional fees and also the inconvenience of leaving while the cleaning team is on-site.

**No Pets:** Exceptions made for registered service animals, but please notify us in advance. If approved, guests are responsible for cleaning up after their pets and ensuring they do not cause damage or disturbances. Pets are not to be left alone unless crated.

**Quiet Hours:** To respect our neighbors and maintain a peaceful environment, we ask that you observe quiet hours from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM. During this time, please keep noise levels to a minimum, particularly when outdoors.

**Outdoor Amenities:** When using the BBQ grill, pizza oven, fire pit table, or wood-burning fireplace, please follow the provided safety guidelines and never leave these amenities unattended in use.

**Outdoor Fires:** There are no fires allowed outside of the grill and fire table. When using the grill or fire table please adhere to local fire regulations and guidelines. Do not leave the fire unattended and always fully extinguish it before leaving the area.

**Piano:** Use of the living room piano is not permitted unless you have taken lessons or have trained to do so. This is a

family keepsake.

**Trash Disposal:** Dispose of trash in the designated bins. Please ensure all trash is bagged and securely tied before placing it in the bins. No trash outside.

**Maintenance and Damage Reporting:** In case of any issues or damages, please notify us immediately so we can address the problem promptly. Guests will still be held responsible for any unreported damages.

**Furniture and Amenities:** Please treat the furniture and amenities with care and return them to their original locations before departure. Please don't rearrange the appliances or furniture.

**Personal Belongings:** Please ensure you take all personal belongings with you upon departure. We cannot be held responsible for any items left behind, but will do our best to find and return.

**Safety and Security:** Please lock all doors and windows when leaving the property or going to bed. Familiarize yourself with the location of fire extinguishers and emergency exits. **Do not leave traces of food outside or in your vehicles as it will attract bears.**

**Cleanliness:** We ask that you maintain the cleanliness of the cabin during your stay. Kindly remove your shoes when entering the cabin. Please don't eat or drink in the bedrooms.

**Respect for Nature:** As our cabin is located in a beautiful natural setting, we ask that you respect the environment by not littering, disturbing wildlife, or damaging any natural features.

**Courtesy:** Treat our cabin with the same respect and care as you would your own home.

**Availability:** As hosts we will make ourselves as available as possible to you during your stay. Please know that we are reachable virtually within standard business hours. If after this window, expect some delays in our responses. Should there be an emergency please call 911 and say "I'm at Wintergreen"

**General Note:** Breaking any of these House Rules may result in immediate termination of your reservation. Guests will be required to vacate the property, and no refund will be provided for any remaining nights. Additionally, any damages caused as a result of violating these rules will be charged to the guest.



# How to Be a BearWise Guest



## Welcome to Bear Country

Black bears are curious, smart, resourceful and always looking for food. While seldom aggressive, black bears are powerful, unpredictable wild animals. Follow these BearWise guidelines to help keep people, pets and property safe, and bears wild.

## Stash & Latch Trash



- Put all trash, food scraps and recycling in containers or enclosures provided.
- Make sure containers are **completely** closed and locked.
- Take trash with you if containers are full; don't leave it on the ground.
- Never store trash in a vehicle or on porch/deck/upper-level balcony.

## Discourage Break-ins



- Keep exterior building doors closed, even when you are there. Lock doors at night.
- When you leave during the day, lock all windows and doors. Screens don't keep out bears.
- Lock vehicles; don't leave windows open even a crack. Remove anything with an odor (food, drinks, trash, scented products).
- Never store food, beverages, pet food, coolers on porches/decks.

## Don't Feed Bears



- Feeding bears or using food to encourage bears to approach you is always dangerous and often illegal.
- Don't put out food to attract birds or small wildlife. You will attract bears, skunks and other critters.
- Throw food scraps into the trash, not "the woods." Even "harmless" scraps like apple cores teach bears to associate people with food.

## Keep a Lookout During Cookouts



- Keep food and coolers within arm's reach; never leave unattended, even for a few minutes.
- Clean picnic tables after every meal. Remove all condiments and food.
- Store grill utensils inside and clean grill after every use.
- Never burn food scraps or trash in your fire ring or grill.

## If You Encounter a Bear



- If a bear comes near your place, scare it away by making noise from a safe distance: yell, clap hands, bang pots together, use an air horn.
- Never try to get closer for a photo.
- Don't corner a bear; give it an escape route. Alert your host.

## Outdoor Safety



- Hike in groups and stay together, especially kids.
- If you see a bear, watch quietly from a safe distance (at least 50 yards or 10 car lengths for black bears; 100 yards for grizzlies). Never approach.
- Never run from a bear. Carry bear spray (if permitted) and know how to use it. Learn more at BearWise.org.
- Be aware that bears are good swimmers and may enjoy the water, even with people around.

## Traveling with Dogs?



- Keep dogs on non-retractable leashes at all times, or leave them at home. Don't force a bear to defend itself.
- Don't let dogs bark at, harass, chase or corner a bear.
- Keep pet food in your room/cabin. Feed dogs inside, if possible. Never leave food/water bowls outside.
- If your dog gets into an encounter with a bear, don't try to rescue it. You will get injured. Use bear spray; it works from 30 feet away.

Ask your host if bears have been active in the area. Follow any recommended special precautions and local regulations.

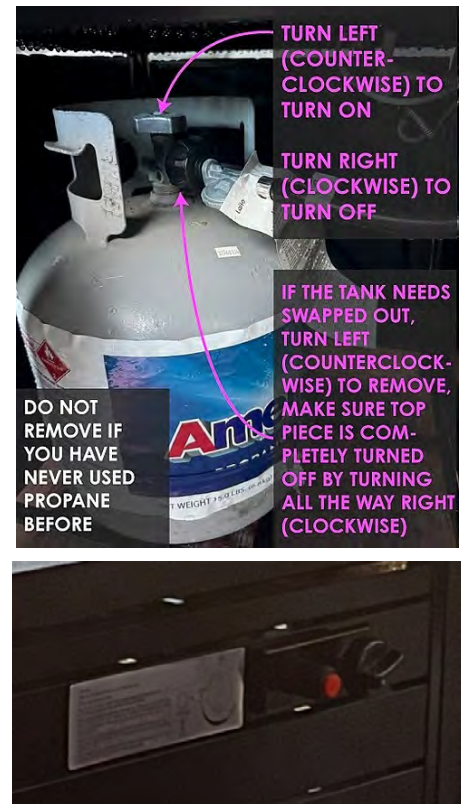
Black bear is a species; common colors include black, brown and cinnamon.



## Fire Pit Table Safety Guidelines:

### READ BEFORE OPERATING

- 1.) Remove Fire Table Cover and Metal Cover Insert. (see photo #1)
- 2.) Open the propane valve using the hand turn on top of the tank. (see photo #2)
- 3.) Follow instructions found on the silver plate (see photo #3)
- 4.) **\*Important\*** When finished do not put the metal cover plate back on until it cools down.
- 5.) **\*Important\*** Turn off the propane when finished (turn to the right, clockwise) (see photo #2)



**-Do not cook food or burn any item:** It's not rated for cooking, use grill for food.

**-Clear the surrounding area:** Ensure that the area around the fire pit table is clear of any flammable materials, such as leaves, branches, or outdoor fabrics.

**-Keep a safe distance:** Maintain a minimum distance of 2-3 feet between the fire pit table and any guests, furniture, or structures to prevent accidents and fires.

**-Timer awareness:** Familiarize yourself with the built-in timer on the fire pit table. Avoid resetting the timer multiple times in quick succession to prevent gas build-up and potential hazards.

**-Supervision:** Always have an adult present while the fire pit table is in use, and never leave the fire unattended.

**-Extinguish the fire:** When you're finished using the fire pit table, ensure the flames are fully extinguished and the propane is turned off. Allow the fire pit table to cool down completely before covering or touching any components.



## Living Room Wood-burning Fireplace Safety Guidelines:

**Inspect the fireplace:** Before using the fireplace, visually inspect the firebox, grate, and flue for any signs of damage or obstructions. If you notice any issues, please notify the property owner before using the fireplace.

**Open the flue:** Ensure that the flue is fully open before starting a fire to allow proper ventilation and prevent smoke from entering the living area.

**Use the right materials:** Use only seasoned hardwood logs for burning, and avoid using green wood, paper, or flammable liquids, as they can produce excessive smoke, creosote buildup, or cause a chimney fire.

**Building the fire:** Place the logs on the grate, leaving space between them for proper airflow. Use kindling or fire starters to ignite the fire, and then gradually add logs as needed.

**Keep a safe distance:** Maintain at least 3 feet of clearance between the fireplace and any furniture, decor, or flammable materials.

**Supervision:** Never leave a fire unattended, and ensure that there is always an adult present while the fireplace is in use.

**Use fireplace tools:** Utilize the provided fireplace tools, such as a poker or tongs, when adjusting the logs or tending to the fire to avoid burns or injuries.

**Extinguish the fire:** Allow the fire to burn down naturally, and avoid using water to extinguish it, as this can cause thermal shock to the fireplace components. Once the fire is out and the embers are cool, use a fireplace shovel to remove the ashes, placing them in a metal container with a tight-fitting lid.

By following these basic safety guidelines, you can enjoy the warmth and ambiance of the wood-burning fireplace while minimizing risks and maintaining a safe and comfortable environment for everyone.

# HIKING



## Crabtree Falls

3.6 Miles | Moderate | 1,135 Elev Gain | Out & Back

Crabtree falls hike offers a number of great views of the waterfalls along the way as you wander through the mountainside. The trails can get muddy and slippery after a heavy rain so please be mindful of your footing. The lower portion of the trail is wheelchair accessible during dry conditions. There is a \$3 fee to enter the parking area off of SR 56. Note: There is no drinking water available at this location.



## Upper Shamokin Falls and Morgan's Loop

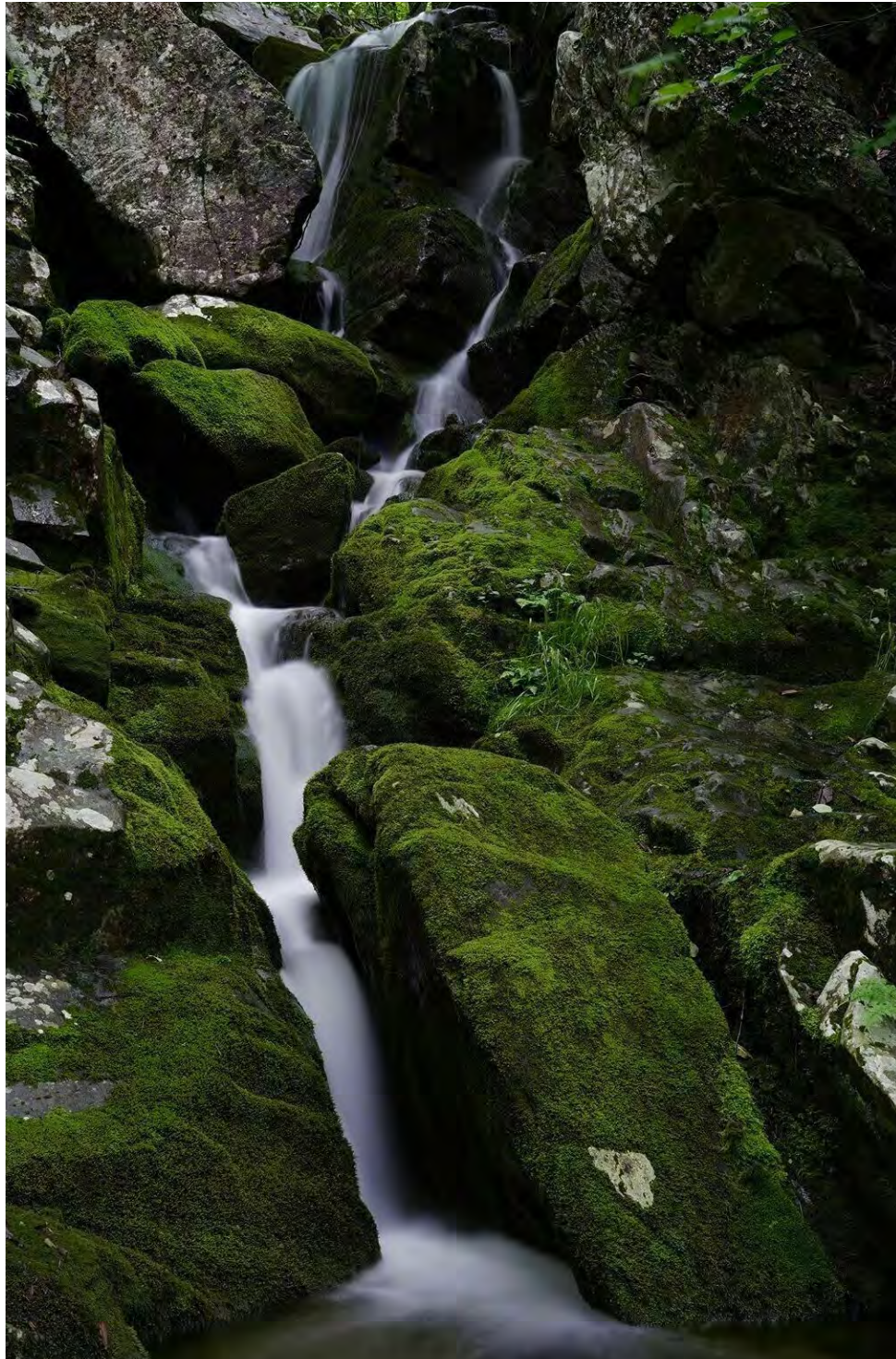
0.8 Miles | Moderate | 272ft Elev Gain | Loop

This quick but fantastic trail is less than 8 minutes away making it an ideal hike to try out. The trail is best used from April until November. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.

## White Rock Falls Loop

4.6 Miles | Moderate | 980ft Elev Gain | Loop

Great trail with a of open vistas, waterfalls, and narrower ethereal paths through the forest. Also a nice mix of steeper inclines and flatter ground to give your legs a break. The trail offers a number of activity options and is best used from March until November. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash. Some have reported that cell service is poor in the area. It is recommended that you download offline maps prior to arriving at the trailhead to avoid getting lost. This loop combines three separate trails: The “White Rock Gap” trail, the “Slacks” Trail, and the “White Rock Falls” Trail.



## Three Ridges Trail

13.6 Miles | Hard | 3,864ft Elev Gain | Loop

If you're more of an avid hiker you could opt to explore part of the Appalachian Trail with this 13.3-mile loop. Alltrails considers it a challenging route, it takes an average of 7 h 57 min to complete. This is a very popular area for backpacking, birding, and camping, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The trail is open year-round and is beautiful to visit anytime. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash.

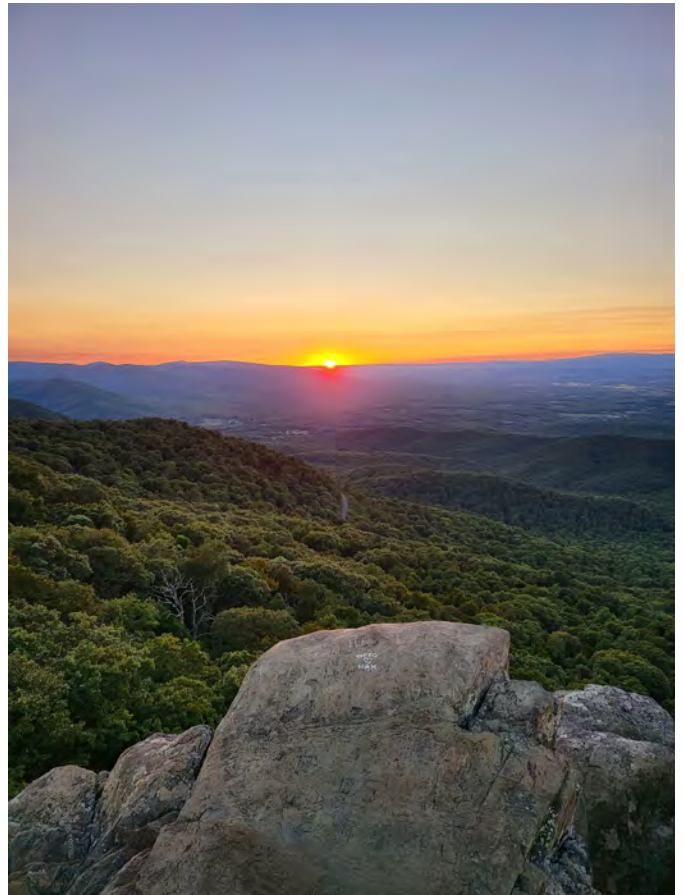


## Humpback Rocks

1.8 Miles | Moderate | 787ft Elev Gain | Out & Back

Enjoy this 1.8-mile out-and-back trail near Lyndhurst, Virginia. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 20 min to complete. This is a very popular area for birding and hiking, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The best times to visit this trail are April through October. Dogs are welcome and may be off-leash in some areas. trail is steep and strenuous, providing challenging climbs with beautiful panoramic views at the summit. Potential for mud after rains, making sturdy footwear essential for the hike. Overall, a rewarding outdoor experience.

## Blue Ridge Tunnel

4.6 Miles | Moderate | 370ft Elev Gain | Out & Back

Although only 2.25 miles long, the Blue Ridge Tunnel Trail has plenty of wow factor. After nearly 20 years of effort by Nelson County, the rail trail passes through a 4,700-foot tunnel bored through the Blue Ridge Mountains of central Virginia, originally constructed between 1850 and 1858. Spanning nearly a mile long, it was the longest tunnel in America at the time of its completion. It's mostly flat with some uphill sections, making it stroller-friendly. Recommend bringing flashlights or headlamps due to the darkness in the tunnel. The tunnel provides a cool respite on warmer days, and it can get crowded, especially on weekends.

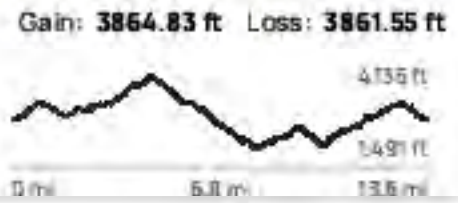
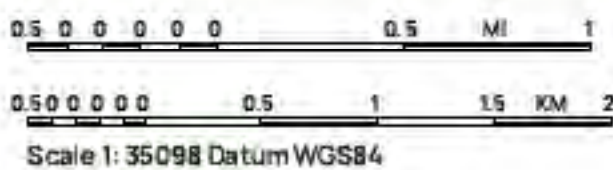


White Rock Falls Loop

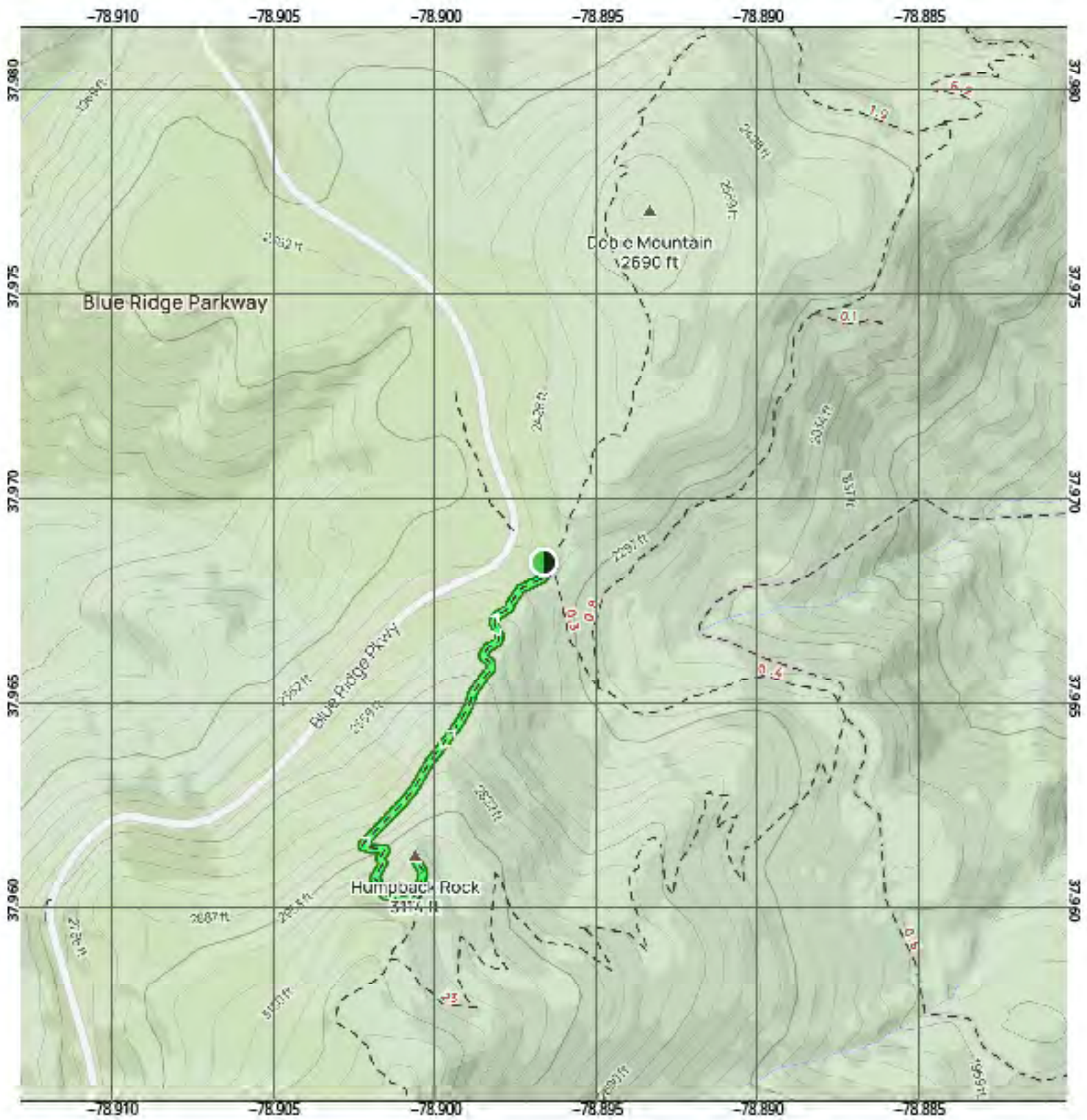
